#### Registration

Registration can be done online at

www.nridgeville.org/parksandrec or at our office Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Our office is located at 7327 Avon Belden Rd. North Ridgeville, OH 44039, across from the City Hall entrance. In the event that summer camp weeks fill up your child can be added to a waitlist. You must be preregistered for camp; a \$5.00 down payment is due when registering. Full payment for summer camp is due the Wednesday before each week that your child attends.

#### **Morning Arrival/Sign-In**

Our day begins at 7:30 a.m., Monday through Friday. Summer Adventure Camp is held at South Central Park. You may drop your child off between 7:30 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. Pick up will be at Pavilion 1 or Pavilion 2 (depending on which group your child is assigned) in South Central Park. Counselors will not be available prior to 7:30 a.m.

There will be camp counselors outside to monitor at all times. If you need to speak with our camp director or assistant camp director please park in the parking lot and walk with your child. Please do not leave your child unattended. Attached to this packet is a map for location information.

Safety is our main priority. In the event of inclement weather the pick-up and drop-off location may change. Please make sure to check your email.

If an individual not listed on the registration form is required to pick up a child (carpooling, going with a friend, etc.) the parent/legal guardian must submit a note prior to the designated person picking up the child.

If your child is ill, running a fever, and/or suspected to be contagious, please <u>DO NOT</u> bring him/her to camp. Please call us and let us know if your child will be absent from camp. Please email Melissa Shirley at <u>mshirley@nridgeville.org</u> or leave a message at 440-353-1503.

Pick up and drop off will be at Pavilion 1 in South Central Park. Our day starts at 7:30 a.m. and ends at 5:30 p.m. Camp hours are 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.



#### Afternoon Pick Up/Sign Out

You may pick your child up between 3:00-5:30 p.m. Our day ends at 5:30 p.m. Please sign out your child before picking them up from camp. If you are picking them up early, please make sure that a note has been written to inform camp staff.

When signing your child out, if the daily sign-out space for your child is highlighted, this means a staff member needs to speak with you. Please see any camp staff before leaving that day.

Parents are reminded that our staff supervision is during camp hours only. Please be sure to pick up and drop off your children at the stated times.

Important: If you need to speak to our Assistant Camp Director, park your car and wait until pick up is over.

#### Carpool

If your child is going home with a friend or has another ride, please send a note to camp that morning. We will not permit children to go home with anyone without a written note from the parent or quardian.



All registered campers will receive a Summer Adventure Camp t-shirt to wear while at camp. Please make sure they wear this shirt to camp every day. The camp shirts help the counselors in identifying our campers.

#### **Staffing**

The Summer Adventure Camp site is managed by a qualified staff of one Camp Director, one Assistant Camp Director and three Camp Counselors.

All staff members of the Summer Adventure Camp are qualified and trained to provide quality care for our campers. All camper staff has completed a screening process that meets the requirements set forth by the North Ridgeville Parks and Recreation Department. All staff members are required to complete and pass criminal background checks and a drug/alcohol test.


The Tot & Youth Program Supervisor, Melissa Shirley, from the Parks and Recreation Department is the coordinator of the Summer Adventure Camp program.



#### **Absences**

If a camper will be absent for any reason, please call the Parks and Recreation Department BEFORE 8:30 a.m. at (440) 353-1503. Please leave your child's full name and the reason they will not be attending. If absence is due to a communicable disease, please be sure to inform us so we can send home the proper notification to other camper parents.

If your child is arriving late, please be sure to call as well. All late arrivals will need to report to the Parks and Recreation Department's office. Please do not drop your child off curbside if they are running late, each child needs to be escorted to their counselor.





Campers should bring a packed lunch on field trip days.

#### **Field Trip Information**

We will not be going on field trips in 2021. But we will be having some special guests come and visit us to make this summer fantastic! Check out our calendar at the end of this packet to see all of our special guests that will be making a special visit just to come see you!



#### **Character Counts**

We will be introducing character counts to add a new and exciting way for your child to learn and interact with other campers. Our goal is to teach 10 different themes each week about character. Our hope is to enable campers to make a positive impact on their community. These 10 themes include: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, citizenship, honesty, cooperation, sportsmanship, sharing and perseverance (each theme can be found on the camp calendar on pages 10, 11 and 12).

#### **Healthy Me**

At Summer Adventure Camp 2021 we will be teaching campers about handwashing, germs and other topics about being healthy and safe during COVID-19. Our goal is to implement safe practices in a fun and educational manner for your child to get into the routine of lowering the risks of spreading germs.

#### **Camp Rules & Regulations**

Our goal is to provide your child with a safe and caring atmosphere during their time with us. With this goal in mind, it is essential all campers understand the rules and regulations of Summer Adventure Camp. All campers are expected to follow all the rules below.

- 1. Staff members are to be given proper respect.
- 2. All campers must stay with their assigned counselor or activities director.
- 3. All campers should show proper respect to each other as well as their surroundings.
- 4. Physical violence (i.e. hitting, fighting, throwing, biting, damaging property) and disobedience will not be tolerated. Such action may be grounds for removal from camp and forfeiture of camp fees.
- 5. In and around water all safety rules regarding the Splash Pad will apply.
- 6. Campers are not to display any disruptive or inappropriate behavior toward any person while at camp. The North Ridgeville Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to remove any child who consistently disobeys or breaks the rules stated above. This will result in the forfeiture of camp fees.
- 7. Parents are asked to have their children wear apparel which is appropriate for summer camp activities. We strongly recommend that all campers wear sneakers each day. "Open Toe Shoes" are not recommended while at camp.
- 8. We are **NOT** responsible for items stolen or lost, but we will make every effort to prevent it. Please make sure any and all items are clearly labeled with your child's name. The following list of items are prohibited at camp:
  - a. IPods / MP3 Players
  - b. Video Games (Gameboy, DS, DSi, Nintendo Switch, etc.)
  - c. Knives, any type of weapon
  - d. Toy Guns
  - e. Cell Phones\*

\*It is recommended cell phones be left at home. The Camp Director has access to a phone if parents need to be contacted. If a parent or guardian needs to contact their child or camp staff for any reason, please contact the Parks and Recreation Department at (440) 353-0860. If a child must bring a cell phone, all cell phones must remain in the camper's backpack during camp hours. Campers are not permitted to carry cell phones during camp hours.

- 9. If a child brings any prohibited items to camp, the item will be confiscated and returned to his / her parent at the end of the day. These items are banned in order to eliminate any disruption or safety concerns that may arise from their use.
- 10. Lost & Found items will be kept in a Lost & Found bin at the camp site. If items are not claimed by the end of camp, all items are donated.

#### **Behavior Issues**

North Ridgeville Parks and Recreation Department takes behavior issues very seriously and has protocols to deal with situations involving misbehavior. You will be notified on the day of the offense. In order to keep parents/guardians informed.

Bullying, fighting, inappropriate behavior / language and breaking camp rules will **NOT** be tolerated. Please refer to the behavior grid to learn how our system works. Your child will have the same behavior grid all summer. Consequences depend on the severity of the offense. A report will be filled out for each individual incident and will be available for review upon request.

Please keep in mind that North Ridgeville Parks and Recreation reserves the right to change our behavior procedures based on the severity of the incident.

#### **Camper of the Week**

Camper of the Week is a special tradition for Summer Adventure Camp. Each week two campers are chosen and announced in front of the entire camp on Friday afternoon before we wrap up the week. Every week staff will reflect on campers' cooperation, camp spirit, generosity, honesty, integrity, positive attitude, and citizenship.

Counselors and the Program Supervisor discuss which campers best exemplify that week's theme characteristic. They then decide two campers who might be honored as campers of the week. The area heads meet with the general counselors and specialty heads to discuss which campers best exemplify that week's theme characteristic. They then vote for the campers who might be honored as campers of the week. The chosen campers receive a certificate, camper of the week shirt and a fun sweet treat. Being honored as a camper of the week is a very big honor and we are so proud of those who achieve this recognition!





#### **COVID-19 Information**

At Summer Adventure Camp, the health and safety of our campers and staff is our top priority. All staff has been made aware of protocols for COVID-19. We want to assure you that North Ridgeville Parks & Recreation is staying up to date on the recent developments by monitoring the CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention), Ohio Department of Health and Lorain County Public Health. We take creating a clean and safe environment for the community seriously.

NRPRD is in regular communication with Lorain County Public Health and will take our instructions from them. We are actively examining and modifying our arrival screening and health response procedures for Summer Adventure Camp 2021. Cleaning procedures are being updated to include the specific anti-viral measures suggested/required by Lorain County Public Health. We are committed to providing regular updates about our plans, policies, and new protective and reactive procedures.

Campers will be assigned to two teams that will be with the same counselors each week that they will be attending camp. All camp staff is required to wear a mask while on the job. Staff will not be able to return to work until they are without fever for 72 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication and demonstrate improvement in respiratory symptoms and at least 7 days since the onset of symptoms have passed.

Upon arrival campers will be asked to wash their hands. After hand washing is complete, campers may go to designated team pavilion that is assigned by Program Supervisor Melissa Shirley. Each team (2) will consist of 15 children socially distanced in our outdoor pavilions. We will be increasing cleaning habits to ensure your child has a safe environment by wiping items during and after each use. All 2021 onsite field trips have been cancelled. Activities will be geared towards social distancing and there will be no sharing of items. Campers will be asked to wash hands before leaving summer Adventure Camp each day. Hand sanitizer will be readily available on site for campers and staff to use.

During inclement weather campers will stay with their team (group) and will be escorted by designated staff to the Community Cabin, Safetyville, Senior Center or North Ridgeville Library. Campers will be asked to wear a mask when going indoors. If they do not have a mask one can be provided. This will be communicated via email by Program Supervisor Melissa Shirley.
